Having been a member of The Company since 1965 and a Fellow since 1973, his many and varied activities reflect great credit upon himself and the Company of Military Historians.

Lt. Col. Emerson has researched, written about, and collected US Army insignia for over 40 years. He retired from the US Army with 20 years of service including two tours in Vietnam. He manages a website devoted to US Army insignia at www.emersoninsignia.net.
