Dear CMH Member:

The member roster shows that you have been a member of the Company of Military Historians for fifty years or more. That's quite an accomplishment!

As the Chair and Co-Chairmen of the 2020/21 Annual Meeting of the Company, we'd like to encourage you to participate in the Annual Meeting if you possibly can. You have the option of participating in person or remotely via teleconference (either phone or computer). The meeting will be held May 27-30, 2021 at the Crowne Plaza, Princeton, NJ. Our itinerary includes 9 lectures and, (for in-person attendees), several field trips. There are a number of items that will – we hope – make this a meeting you can and will want to attend:

- Special recognition of 50-year members – our “Old Guard” during the (Thursday) Welcome Reception and the (Saturday) banquet.
- Ample space for exhibits and sales tables to show or sell portions of your collection. For those who attend remotely, we are scheduling 15-minute slots where you can, if you wish, ‘show and tell’ one or more items in your collection.
- We have special accommodations throughout the weekend for folks with mobility challenges:
  - If you don't drive, you can simply take a train (AMTRAK, NJ Transit and – via Trenton -- SEPTA) to the Princeton Junction Transit hub. The hotel is a short (less than five mile) cab ride from Princeton Junction.
  - The hotel is providing a golf cart to ride between hotel lobby and meeting rooms.
  - Our transportation options for the ‘Ten Crucial Days’ field trip include door-to-door service for people who don't want to walk between parking lots and museum sites.
- We are offering discounted registration for you and a guest if you bring along a companion or aide who has never attended a meeting. (‘Recruit’ and ‘recruiter’ of first-time attendees each get a \$25 break on cost of full registration.

The 50-year members who are also Fellows may remember the days when we had annual Fellows meetings. We're not doing that, but we are offering a special workshop and presentation for Fellows and their guests on Wednesday afternoon and evening prior to the main conference.

I sincerely hope you will consider joining us – either in person or via teleconference at the 2020/21 Annual Meeting of the Company of Military Historians May 27-30, 2021 at the Crowne Plaza, Princeton, NJ
