The 2026 Meeting Will be held in historic Saratoga Springs, NY. The

headquarters will be at the Holiday Inn. The hotel is centrally located at the entrance to Saratoga Springs historic downtown district and is within walking distance of the city's best shopping, restaurants and area attractions. The Planned Trips will be held on Friday and will be to two major National Landmarks. **The first option** will be to the Saratoga National Historic Park, the site of the Battles of Saratoga. The Turning Point of the Revolution and the nearby Saratoga Monument. It is a short 20-minute drive from the hotel. After a time at the visitor center members will be given a guided tour of the vast site. Later in the day there will be a visit to the NYS Military Museum situated in Downtown Saratoga Springs. A special back of the house tour will be arranged for our group.

The second option will be a little over an hour bus ride though the beautiful Adirondack Mountains to the storied Fort Ticonderoga, located at the confluence of Lake George and Lake Champlain; site of battles in the French and Indian War and the Revolution. The restored fort overlooks 2,000 acres of New York Adirondacks and Vermont's Green Mountains and the scenic Lake Champlain. The fort is now the home of one of the pre-eminent Revolutionary War arms collections In the US.
